Competitors Notes

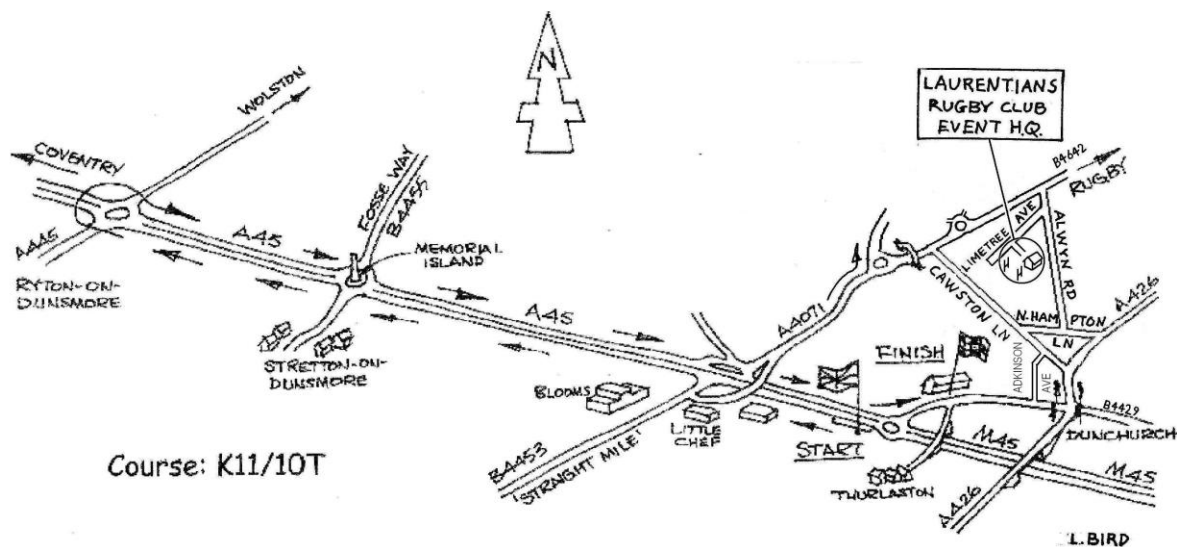
'CTT' recommend that a hard-shell helmet that meets a recognised International Safety Standard should be worn; this is compulsory for U18's, (Regulation 15).

'CTT' also advise that a working, preferably flashing, Rear Light be fitted to all machines.

Course Description:

- SP 462 716: **START**; In the Lay-by 200 yards West of the A45/M45 Thurlaston Island at the 3rd joint in the concrete apron. Ride West along the A45.
- SP 415 732: At the Fosse Way Island, (A45/B4455), take the 2nd exit to continue on the A45.
- SP 391 741: At the next Island, (A45/A445), take the 4th exit to retrace along the A45.
- SP 414 732: At the Fosse Way Island, (A45/B4455), take the 2nd exit to continue on the A45.
- SP 465 715: At the A45/M45 Island, take 1st exit onto the B4429 towards Thurlaston/Dunchurch.
- SP 465 715: **FINISH**; 60 yards past the right turn to Thurlaston, (Main Street); in line with the Eastern (exposed) Gate Post; immediately past the property named 'Newhaven'.



Competitors Notes:

The Event headquarters will be open from 12.30pm. There is a large Car Park in the Drive-way & should this fill up you may be directed to use an area on the far side of the Sports Pitches.

Numbers will be issued only when a Competitor has 'signed on'; exchange your Number for a free drink after your ride.

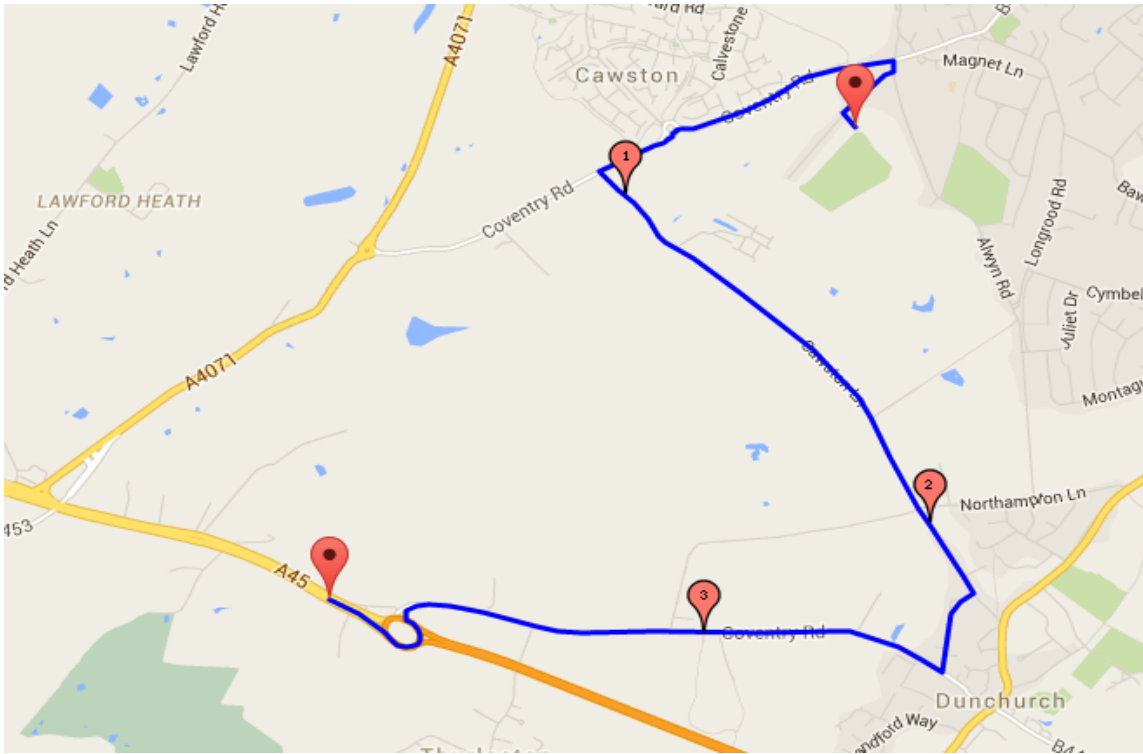
Please note this is a Type A Event & as such sleeveless tops are not permitted, (Regulation 16); "sleeves shall be at least mid-upper arm in length".

Please do not warm up on the Course; we have previously had complaints from other competitors, particularly on the B4429 run in to the Finish. Competitors have needed to either brake or pull out in front of vehicles approaching from behind. It also causes confusion for the Finish Timekeeper. We suggest using the A45 to the East of Dunchurch, in the direction of Willoughby & Daventry.

Handicaps have been set according to data taken from the CTT Standard Chart, based on best times at the distance during the last three years where this information was available.

Veterans Standards have been taken from the Revised 2013 VTTA Chart.

It is nearly four miles from the HQ to the Start; please allow sufficient time to be ready for the Time Keeper. See the following map for the recommended route to the Start, this will be signed using CTT Direction Arrows; please avoid using the A4071/A45 as this utilises the final section of the Course.

Who was Diana Cooke'?

Diana was a keen member of Coventry CC through her teenage years and up to her untimely death. Diana was an ever present face on Club Runs and at Social Events; often participating in Club Time Trials. A very popular young lady amongst her peers, she was acting editor of the Club's magazine 'The Milestone'.

During that period the Cooke's were a cycling family; Diana was the younger sister of Chris and Tony, both prominent racing members of Coventry CC. Were Diana still with us today she would be an Aunt to Olympic & multiple World Champion Nicole Cooke.
